People: This concern for each other includes assisting in physical sustenance according to our various abilities and needs. Our sharing extends to all of those, wherever they live, who call on the name of the Lord Jesus, as the Lord provides to us opportunity.

Leader: This sharing, which the saints have with Jesus Christ, does not in any way enable us to take part in his deity. Nor does it make us equal with Jesus Christ in any respect. To suggest or to affirm either lacks respect for him and seeks to make him less than who he really is.

People: The common sharing of the saints with each other neither removes nor infringes on the ownership each person has over his or her possessions.
