Heidelberg Catechism, Questions 27 - 28

Leader: *What do you understand by the providence of God?*

People: Providence is the almighty and ever present power of God by which he upholds, as with his hand, heaven and earth and all creatures, and so rules them that leaf and blade, rain and drought, fruitful and lean years, food and drink, health and sickness, prosperity and poverty, all things, in fact, come to us not by chance but from his fatherly hand.

Leader: *How does the knowledge of God's creation and providence help us?*

People: We can be patient when things go against us, thankful when things go well, and for the future we can have good confidence in our faithful God and Father that nothing will separate us from his love. All creatures are so completely in his hand that without his will they can neither move nor be moved.

Leader: *Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, O God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness.*

People: O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise.

Leader: *For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering.*

People: The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Leader: *Do good to Zion in your good pleasure; build up the walls of Jerusalem;*

People: Then will you delight in right sacrifices, in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings; then bulls will be offered on your altar.
