Leader: *What happened to man in the fall?*

People: Man fell into a condition of sin and misery.

Leader: *What is sinful about man's fallen condition?*

People: The sinfulness of that fallen condition is twofold. First, in what is commonly called original sin, there is the guilt of Adam's first sin with its lack of original righteousness and the corruption of his whole nature. Second are all the specific acts of disobedience that comes from original sin.

Leader: *What is the misery of man's fallen condition?*

People: By their fall all mankind lost fellowship with God and brought His anger and curse on themselves. They are therefore subject to all the miseries of this life, to death itself, and to the pains of hell forever.

Leader: *Did God leave all mankind to die in sin and misery?*

People: From all eternity and merely because it pleased Him God chose some to have everlasting life. These He freed from sin and misery by a covenant of grace and brought them to salvation by a redeemer.

Confession of Sin

Leader: *What good does it do you, however, to believe all this?*

People: In Christ I am right with God and heir to life everlasting.

Leader: *How are you right with God?*

People: Only by true faith in Jesus Christ. Even though my conscience accuses me of having grievously sinned against all God's commandments and of never having kept any of them, and even though I am still inclined toward all evil, nevertheless, without my deserving it at all, out of sheer grace, God grants and credits to me the perfect satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness of Christ, as if I had never sinned nor been a sinner, as if I had been as perfectly obedient as Christ was obedient for me. All I need to do is to accept this gift of God with a believing heart.

Leader: *Why do you say that by faith alone you are right with God?*

People: It is not because of any value my faith has that God is pleased with me. Only Christ's satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness make me right with God. And I can receive this righteousness and make it mine no other way than by faith alone.
