***Confession of Faith** Westminster Shorter Catechism, 33-36

Leader: *What is justification?*

People: Justification is the act of God's free grace by which He pardons all our sins and accepts us as righteous in His sight. He does so only because He counts the righteousness of Christ as ours. Justification is received by faith alone.

Leader: *What is adoption?*

People: Adoption is the act of God's free grace by which we become His sons with all the rights and privileges of being His.

Leader: *What is sanctification?*

People: Sanctification is the work of God's free grace by which our whole person is made new in the image of God, and we are made more and more able to become dead to sin and alive to righteousness.

Leader: *What benefits in this life go with or come from justification, adoption, and sanctification?*

People: The benefits that in this life go with or come from justification, adoption, and sanctification are: the assurance of God's love, peace of conscience, joy in the Holy Spirit, and growing and persevering in grace to the end of our lives.
