*Confession of Faith Heidelberg Catechism, Question 103

Leader: *What is God's will for us in the fourth commandment?*
People: First, that the gospel ministry and education for it be maintained, and that, especially on the festive day of rest, I regularly attend the assembly of God's people to learn what God's Word teaches, to participate in the sacraments, to pray to God publicly, and to bring Christian offerings for the poor.
